The comments received highlighted a preference for nature-based solutions, stricter floodplain management/flood protection goals, flood response and flood warning activities for disabled community, and comments from the US Army Corps of Engineers.

The Group discussed FMEs and scoring methodology to rank FMEs within the Neches flood planning region. Primary FMEs were ranked based on the scoring model.
